"County Photographer" Phil Norton came to Ontario from Quebec in 2007 where he owned and operated an apple-maple syrup farm while working as a freelance photojournalist. He worked 6 years at The Montreal Gazette as the Stock Photo Administrator and shooting daily news assignments.
